GROUND MAINTENANCE TECHNICIANS (PART-TIME)

The Airport Maintenance Department is currently accepting applications for part-time Grounds Maintenance Techs (25 to 30 hours per week). Grounds Techs perform a variety of duties related to maintaining the cleanliness of the airport grounds, roadways, and parking lots. Duties include but not limited to: mowing, weed eating, edging, trimming and pruning of trees/ hedges; cleaning ditches, inspecting roadways, removing debris and general day to day maintenance duties.

Grounds Techs must possess a basic working and operational knowledge of landscape maintenance and an understanding of the principles and practices of safety management in compliance with regulations and guidelines involving the use of various equipment and machinery including riding mowers, weed eaters, chainsaws, tractors, and other maintenance equipment. Applicants must possess any combination of experience and training that provide the required knowledge and abilities. High school diploma or equivalent and a valid South Carolina Drivers License required. Entry level pay is \$12.00 per hour. No benefits associated with these part-time positions with the exception of accrued time off on a prorated basis.
